Clear Path X - Social Media Drill April 14, 2022; 10am-2pm ET

On April 14, 2022, the Clear Path X Exercise Series will host a Social Media Drill. This virtual, interactive exercise will offer participants the opportunity, through a simulated social media tool, to work with industry and government partners and practice delivering credible and actionable messaging to inform the public during a catastrophic incident.

Training Dates:

- Player Inbrief/Training Session: Tuesday, April 12, 2022, from 1pm-2pm ET
- Drill Conduct: Thursday, April 14, 2022, from 10am-2pm ET

Recommended Participants: Operations and management-level public affairs personnel who would be responsible for coordinating public information and utilizing social media during a catastrophic incident. Participation is open and recommended to:

- Federal, state, and local emergency management and energy offices
- Public and private sector energy providers from electricity, oil, and natural gas
- Industry trade associations/mutual aid network coordinators

Training Goals and Objectives:

- Core Capability: Public Information and Warning
- **Objective:** Develop and distribute accurate and timely public information messaging through social media platforms in response to a multi-region incident

How to Participate:

- 1. Register for the drill no later than March 15, 2022 at: https://ess.ascenttra.com/Registration/Clear_Path_X_Social_Media_Drill/index.cfm
 Registration is required so that players can be issued their exercise credentials to access the social media simulation system and virtual conference (Zoom) platform.
- 2. Prior to the exercise, players will receive instructions for accessing Zoom and the social media simulation system through email.
- 3. On April 12, 2022, log into Zoom beginning at 12:45 am ET for a short player briefing and orientation to the Social Media Simulation Tool.
- 4. On April 14, 2022, log into Zoom and Social Medial Simulator by 9:45 AM ET. Once the drill begins, respond to the simulated social media messages as you would during a real incident, using the provided simulated social media accounts.
- 5. You will have the ability to coordinate your messages and discuss messaging strategy with other players through designated Zoom channels.
- 6. Upon conclusion of the drill at 1:30pm ET, participate in a debrief to discuss strengths and areas for improvement.
